Cancer fight bikers roll in

SHOPPERS' HEADS turned as a posse of Harley-Davidson motor-bikes thundered along Princes Street in Edinburgh yesterday, writes *Kirsten Gray*.

Twelve of the 15 bikers were women who have bravely battled breast cancer.

They'd just completed a 1000-mile trip from London in the UK leg of Changing Gears — The Global Run.

Taking a slightly round-about

route, they'd spent the previous night in Stirling, giving them an opportunity to make a grand entrance across the Forth Road Bridge.

The trek aims to raise awareness of the needs of younger women living with breast cancer while raising funds.

It heads off to the US next month, then Australia in October and follows the success of the first 1000-mile Changing Gears tour held in the States last year.
