

## Cancer survivor to ride from Brisbane to Sydney

WITH a Harley Davidson and an eye for adventure, Robyn Hines is taking to the road.

Ms Hines will ride her motorbike from Brisbane to Sydney as a participant in the last Amazon Heart Thunder Ride in May.

The Springwood resident is a breast cancer survivor who's keen to raise funds towards research and support for those still battling the disease.

Ms Hines was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2006.

"I was one of the lucky ones," she said. "The breast cancer I had was the most easily treated and has the highest survival rate.

"In June last year, my oncologist said there was no need to see me ever again."

To raise funds for the ride, Ms Hines is planning a poker run and rolling bike show for March 29.

It is open to all bikes and all levels of experience.

The poker run would see registered participants draw four cards throughout the course of the day and the person with the best hand when the ride is over wins a prize.

The rolling bike show sees representatives from different bike companies who specialise in different bikes judging the bikes all day, with prizes and trophies to be awarded to the winners of different categories.

The ride costs \$20 a head with registration at 8am at Blacktown Harley and a rain day on April 5.

The course starts at Blacktown Harley and travels up to the Orient Hotel in Springwood before finishing at the Crossroads Hotel at Liverpool.
